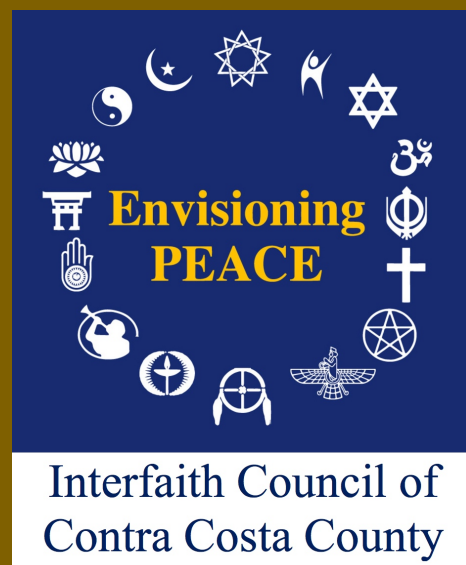


- Is your congregation ready to help your congregants and neighbors in the case of a large-scale emergency?
