Now the 4th Retreat, the Sept 19th retreat has been postponed and put online on Sunday, Feb. 6th from 3-6 pm with no dinner:

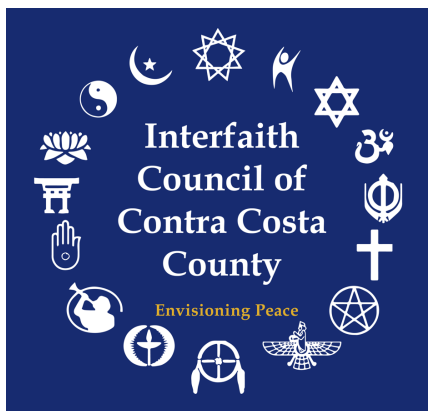
